### **BRIGHTLINGSEA HARBOUR ACCESS**

Water depth in the main channel is 1m below chart datum. All tide access.

The ground is a very soft silty mud which allows keels to sink in.

### **MARINA ACCESS EITHER SIDE OF HIGH WATER**

0.5m keel	4 hrs either side neaps	4.25 hrs either side springs
1.0m keel	3 hrs either side neaps	3.5hrs either side springs
1.5m keel	2.5hrs either side neaps	3hrs either side springs
2.0m keel	2hrs either side neaps	2hrs either side springs

There is a tide gauge at the entrance of the marina, also on our website. Please check before entering.

The ground is a very soft silty mud in suspension which allows keels to sink in for those with longer keels.

### **DESTINATIONS**

From River to Sea – within 2miles

Sail to Bradwell – 3 hours / Power Boat 1hour

Sail to Wivenhoe / Rowhedge – 2 hours / Power Boat 45mins

Sail to Ipswich, leave before high water – 8 hours / Power Boat 2 hours

Morgan Marine has a 30t Wise hoist, St Osyth Boat Yard can accommodate larger vessels at their dry dock. Here at Brightlingsea Harbour we have the town hard and scrubbing posts which can also take larger vessels that require work done below the water line.
