	The pilot who resigned wrote to the Chair, stating he had some concerns as to the suitability of the new pilot boat. The Chair asked the Commissioner responsible for navigational safety (Colin Watkins, CW) to investigate those concerns. CW has significant professional sea experience, including vessel commands.	
	 Having investigated the concerns, CW reported back that he; Had spoken with both the Harbour Master and Deputy Harbour Master, Viewed the Coding and Safety Certificates, Viewed the Record of Safety Drills, Viewed the training logs of the vessel's crew, Inspected the vessel Colne Leader and personally rigged the MOB recovery equipment. 	
	CW noted that the Colne Leader is Coded as a Small Work Boat with Pilot Boat Endorsement. As such it meets all the requirements set down by the MCA and YDSA and in many areas exceeds them. Other Brightlingsea Pilots continue to use the vessel and express satisfaction with its operation.	

	CW informed the Chair that he is content that the vessel is "fit for purpose."
